Also, infiltration experiments are performed in which the seepage line and land side seepage is measured.

The research dike is situated on the containment area „Radelsee“ between Rostock-Warnemünde and Markgrafenheide. You may either come from Markgrafenheide or from Warnemünde (ferry Hohe Düne).
